#### PRESIDENT OF THE HELLENIC SWIMMING FEDERATION



## **CONGRESS VENUE**






The European Aquatics Congress will take place at the Hellenic Olympic Committee Headquarters.

The headquarters of the HOC are on Dimitrios Vikelas avenue, in Halandri, which it is approximately 200m away from the Olympic Stadium of Athens. The building was constructed in 1999, it has a conference hall with a capacity of 300 persons equipped with all technical means to host the European Aquatics Congress.

Transportation between the hotel and the Congress Venue will be arranged by the LOC. Distance from the Hotel to the Congress Venue is approx. 14km (about 20min.)
