

# LEN EUROPEAN U23 SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025

## Preliminary Agreement Key Requirements

Entered into on the 4<sup>th</sup> of January 2023

between **LIGUE EUROPEENNE DE NATATION** (hereinafter named LEN)  
9 rue de la Morâche, CH-1260 Nyon, Switzerland

- of the one part – and

**SLOVAKIAN SWIMMING FEDERATION** (hereinafter FED)  
Za kasárňou 1, 831 03 Bratislava, Slovakia

This document is for LEN and FED to agree on the **Key Requirements** for hosting the event. These requirements are found in the following two pages.

By signing, FED accepts them and is obliged to pay 5% of the Event Fee, before the end of February 2023, and then follow the appropriate procedure towards signing the final agreement. It is understood that if FED withdraws from the event after signing this document, there will not be a refund of the above-mentioned payment.

Event: LEN European U23 Swimming Championships 2025

LEN has the right to request FED to change dates of the event but no later than 120 days prior to the event, if LEN finds it absolutely necessary.

Dates of the Event: [4-day program, TBD, 2025]

Event Venue: [TBC, Slovakia]

1. Competition Facilities

- 1.1. Competition pool according to FINA minimum standards; FR 2.
- 1.2. Warm-Up / Cool Down pool; 25 or 50m x 8 or 10 lanes.
- 1.3. Gym area with free weights, cross training equipment and weight machines. Aerobic machines (e.g., treadmills, stationary bikes) are optional.
- 1.4. Dryland area.
- 1.5. Venue's competition pool minimum seating capacity for the Event must be 1500. Provision of accessible seats are mandatory.
- 1.6. Light intensity over starting platforms and turning ends shall not be less than 600 Lux.

2. Training Facilities

- 2.1. Training pool; 25 or 50m x 8 or 10 lanes.
- 2.2. Gym with free weights, cross training equipment and weight machines. Aerobic machines (e.g., treadmills, stationary bikes) are optional.
- 2.3. Located within a 30-minute drive from the team hotels (including rush hour times).

3. Media & TV Facilities

- 3.1. Written press; covered seating for a minimum of 50 people, including 10 fully equipped positions.
- 3.2. Media Center; minimum of 50 positions.
- 3.3. TV Production recommended and according to broadcasting potential.
- 3.4. Streaming to be arranged by FED. To be on a LEN channel.

4. Team Hotels

- 4.1. 3- and 4-star hotel standards. Accommodation and price range to be coordinated with LEN.
- 4.2. Full board accommodation; meals in buffet service. Meals suitable for high level athletes, including dietary and vegan/vegetarian options. Box lunches to be made available upon request.
- 4.3. Located within 30 minutes from the competition venue (including rush hour times).
- 4.4. Free wi-fi service.

5. LEN Accommodation

- 5.1. A total of 150 accommodation units in FB will be granted by LOC to LEN. These will be used for LEN staff and Bureau, delegate and Technical Committee members and other event staff to be provided by LEN. The contract will specify what each party will provide.

5.2. 3- and 4-star hotel standards (and 5-star, if available).

6. Timing & Data Handling

6.1. According to LEN standards.

7. Sport Presentation

7.1. According to LEN standards and approved by LEN.

8. VIP Facilities

8.1. Covered seating for approximately 100 guests.

8.2. Adequate hospitality area (quality & size) next to VIP Tribune to accommodate LEN & LOC guests.

8.3. Catering service.

9. Air & Ground Transportation

9.1. Airport with international connections; maximum 100km from the event venue.

9.2. Free access to public transportation network by presenting accreditation.

9.3. Shuttle service & dedicated cars according to LEN needs.

10. Marketing

10.1. 60% of marketing rights linked to European U23 Swimming Championships will be retained and exploited by LEN; this includes, but is not limited to, sponsorship rights, merchandising rights, corporate hospitality rights, etc. For clarification purposes, the relevant split will be based on visibility (time / space) and not revenue. All details will be outlined in the contract.

11. Guarantee

11.1. FED to guarantee a "clean" venue; free of all commercial or sponsorship identification, franchises, branding or other promotional material 5 days before to the last day of the event.

11.2. Visas; FED to guarantee visa support for participants, team staff and officials.

12. Financial Requirements

12.1. Total of up to a max of €20.000 (twenty thousand euros) for daily allowance. For clarification purposes, the daily allowance per person entitled to per diem and according to LEN common practices for its Events, will be 100 euros.

12.2. Total of €100.000 (one hundred thousand euros) as Event Fee.

13. Contract

13.1. A contract specifying all detailed requirements will be signed between LEN and FED as soon as possible but no later than the end of July 2023.
